Impartiality Statement of CEPREI Certification Body

The survival of CEPREI Certification Body (referred to as CEPREI hereinafter) depends on its providing the certification service credited by the public and relevant interest parties of cerfification. CEPREI is providing certification service with principles of impartiality, science, service and value. Impartiality and being considered as impartial is a necessity for providing certification service with creditability. Any work behavior of you that threatens the impartiality is harmful to the interest of the society, certification client, CEPREI and yourself. The certification fees paid by the client are the income source of CEPREI. It is CEPREI's pursuit to have excellent performance at each step of certification. The fees you pay is used to purchase the certification service credited by the public and certification users. If you expect CEPREI to have compromise in impartiality because of the fees you pay, then you are purchasing the certification service that will not meet your expectations.

CEPREI welcomes the cooperation in certification businesses. Your partnership with CEPREI relies on its public creditability. If CEPREI has

to accept compromise in impartiality during the work with you, then the value of CEPREI's cooperation with you is lost.

CEPREI welcomes the surveillance and improvement suggestions from the public and certification interest parties on the impartiality and quality of CEPREI's work.
